Daniel was born in Poland and brought up in Surrey, before going to Stirling University to study Business Studies with French and Spanish. He then worked in telecommunications for ten years as an international account manager, travelling extensively in Europe, the Middle East and Africa.

Daniel has been the Member of Parliament for Shrewsbury and Atcham since May 2005. He has served on various select committees in Westminster and in the last Parliament, he was also appointed the Prime Minister's Envoy to the Polish and Eastern European Diaspora in the United Kingdom.

Daniel takes a keen interest in Russia. Most recently, speaking in Parliament on the Nord Stream 2 Pipeline, a proposed gas pipeline that would run directly from the Russian Federation to Germany. Currently, Russian gas is transported through the territories of our Eastern European allies. By building a pipeline directly from Russia to Germany, our allies will be left defenceless against greater Russian influence, which would, in turn, endanger the entire NATO alliance.
