1 Council Tax Increases

The Lib Dems recently boasted that the Parish Council's increase in Council Tax for 2023/2024 is below inflation, though at a hefty 8.9%. The Lib Dems omitted to say there was an increase of 9.60% in 2021/2022 when inflation was only 0.99%. Also, the 2022/2023 increase of 7.90% was again well above inflation. Despite rises, in the last three years the Parish Council have lost several members of staff including the Development Officer. Lib Dem Councillors often complain at having "no money" but four years ago there was a healthy budget and reserves left by the Conservatives.

2 The Police Station Site

The site of the old police station is an eyesore. 100% affordable housing isn't an option given the prime location of the site. So we propose using the land for tourist accommodation and recreational facilities to help drive revenue into the area.

3 Flooding Disgrace

Residents living in two roads in the Parish have been ignored since 2015 with severe flooding which threatens to continually damage their homes. Despite the Parish Council initially taking responsibility for the burst pipe causing the issues, the residents are now being ignored. The Lib Dems have wasted over £80k on this fiasco, with a whopping £40k towards legal advice in their pursuit of the residents. We know this because David is Chairman of the local Residents Association which was formed by 16 households as a result of the problem with the Parish Council. There is still no resolution in sight. This is a disgrace and follows similar inaction to repair the seawall in Hythe. Emily and David will work with the relevant authorities to seek urgent resolution to this situation.

5 New Hythe Hospital

Congratulations to all those involved in making a success of the new Hythe Hospital. This could only have been made possible with funds made available by Central government.

4 The Knighton Centre

Hythe village centre must remain the heart of a vibrant local economy, not the location of high-end waterfront apartments, which is why we **oppose** any move to redevelop the area. A planning application looks set to be submitted, we wait with interest.
