Ian & John are a great team, ready to serve Totton!



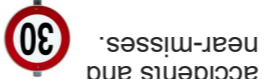

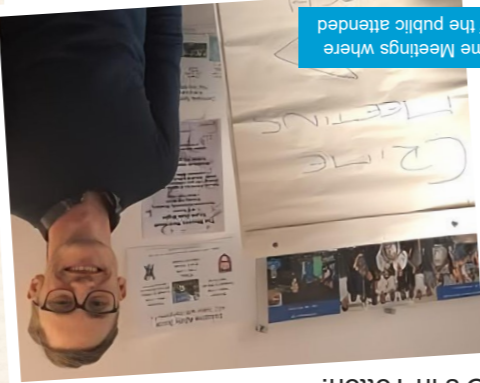
Ilan and John were heavily involved in supporting the local community during the Covid-19 pandemic
